**Returning to School Guidelines following Illness, Injury or Hospitalization**

- Any student who is absent more than five consecutive days, requires a note from a physician to return to school.
- Any student who has been hospitalized for a physical illness, injury, surgical procedures or a mental health issue should provide re-entry documentation from a physician to return to school. (Refer to re-entry packets for mental health issues.)
- Any student requiring an immobilization device, such as a hard splint or cast, may NOT participate in physical education, sports or recess. (Refer to Physical Restrictions Protocol.)
- Any student who has suffered a physical injury resulting in exclusion from Physical Education must provide a note from a physician to return to PE or Sports.
- All students requesting elevator access should have a note from a physician regarding the injury. (Parents may ask for elevator access on the first day and this request should be granted ...please have them fax note from MD or obtain note within 24 hrs.)
